

Can solar panels be installed on all roof materials?

While solar panels can usually be safely and effectively installed on all roof materials, the exact installation processes may differ. As such, there is no " best" roof for solar - panels can go on just about any roof material. Below, we'll look at the various roof materials and how installers secure solar panels to each.

What type of fixing system is used for solar PV panels?

The type of fixing system used will depend on whether the solar PV panels are going to be: ground mounted. Solar PV panels can be retrofitted onto an existing roof, on top of the tiles or other roofing materials, using roof anchors (also called roof-hooks or brackets), mounting rails and clamps.

Ballast systems are simply a weighted racking setup that holds solar panels in place. If you need to drill into your flat roof to install solar panels,don't worry- your solar installer will ensure that the holes they drill are as small as possible and sealed correctly to avoid roof damage or leaking. The guidelines also say that provision must be made for ventilation behind the solar PV modules to provide cooling. 6 ???· However, most flat roofs can"t hold a solar panel system. A good installer will avoid drilling into a flat roof for fear of causing leaks, and will instead use ballasts - each of which weighs 80kg per panel.



A ballast mount is usually an angled, plastic container filled with blocks, with the solar panel securely placed on top of it. In some cases, it can also be necessary to drill the ballast mount into the roof to make it even more stable.
