Your local authority can also apply for a Confiscation Order to take away any money you've earned with your system - so there's absolutely no benefit to installing solar panels that don't meet building regulations. It's crucial that your solar installation follows all building regulations.

While potential problems can arise from solar panel installation on roofs, these can be mitigated with proper planning, professional installation, and regular maintenance. By addressing these potential issues proactively, ...

Your installer must gain building regulations approval from your local authority for their solar panel system plan before they can proceed. They will have to prove your roof can comfortably support the weight of your
