Do solar panels produce more electricity than you can use?

Your solar panel system might produce more electricity than you can use, because you can (usually) only use the electricity it produces in real time. This means if you're out of the house during the day, especially in the summer when solar panel output is high, you might not be able to use all the electricity it generates.

Will my roof generate solar energy?

Can you put solar panels on a roof?

This can be a good option if your roof isn't a suitable place to put a solar panel system. However, they may need foundations and can also be pricey.

How much solar power does a roof use a year?

Truthfully, way more than you probably need. According to our calculations, the average roof can produce about 35,000 kilowatt-hours (kWh) of solar electricity annually--more than three times the amount of electricity the average U.S. home uses annually.
