Are there any permanent archives in the Faroe Islands?

Currently, there are no other permanent archives in the Faroe Islands, but since the end of 2017, the national government has provided financial support for a three-year pilot project under the name " Tvø royrar Skjalasavn", which aims to collect private archives from the area.
