Can solar panels be installed on a house?

If you're getting solar panels installed onto the roof of your house, the installers will need to construct scaffolding around the building before they can crack on with the process. This will take the most time out of all the steps - usually about a day - but will mean the installers can have safe and secure access to the roof.

Do I need permission to install a solar panel?

Under Permitted Development Rights, you won't require formal permission to install a solar panel. However, you will need to check if your home is not exempt under Article 4 of PDR. In a process that takes less than a day, your panel will be fastened to your roof and connected to your home's electricity grid.

How do I choose a solar energy installer?

Look for installers that have a proven track record and check if they are accredited by relevant industry bodies, such as the Microgeneration Certification Scheme (MCS) and/or the Renewable Energy Consumer Code (RECC).
