WeChat Pay is a payment feature integrated into the WeChat app,allowing users to complete payments quickly and securely on their mobile phones. Users can link their bank cards, receive and transfer money, pay bills, and make purchases both in-store and online. Download WeChat from the App Store or Google Play.

How do I pay for utilities & services through WeChat?

You can pay for utilities and services directly through WeChat by navigating to the "Bills" section of the Wallet menu. Keep track of your spending and transfers by regularly checking your WeChat wallet's transaction history.
