#### Can I use bleach on my solar panels?

Avoidusing harsh chemicals like bleach, Windex, or ammonia cleaners on your solar panels. Windex and ammonia cleaners can leave residues that affect the panels' performance, and bleach and other harsh chemicals can damage solar cells and reduce efficiency. 
