Are solar panels free?

Under these agreements, the company installs solar panels on your roof or property for no upfront to you; hence, the "free" terminology.

Are "free" solar panels a good idea?

The concept of "free" or "no-cost" solar panels really is too good to be true. "Free" solar panels are essentially rented from solar companies. While you will reap the benefits of cheaper electricity bills through solar power, you do not own the panels; the solar company does. Once your lease agreement is up, the panels will be removed.

Are free solar panels available in the UK?

At present no, free solar panels are not available in the UK. Back in 2010, many solar companies would practically install solar panels for free, this was largely due to the incentives of the Feed-in tariff. However, since the feed-in tariff ended, this incentive no longer exists and so solar companies are back to charging for solar panel installs.

Can you get free solar panels on a roof?

Companies offered to pay to lease your roof from you for 20-25 years and, in exchange, would install and maintain solar PV panels on it. You didn't have to pay upfront for the panels, and would also benefit from the free electricity produced by the system. But there are very few free solar panel schemes available now.

However, it's important to note that "free" solar panels are not always a scam, but they do require careful consideration. These "free" solar panels are typically offered through solar panel leases or power purchase agreements (PPAs), which allow individuals to install solar panels without the high expense.
