What type of government does Laos have?

Government type: Laos is a Communist state governed by the Lao People's Revolutionary Party. According to the U.S. state department Laos is a "most repressive state" and a "place of unusually harsh government control." The republic democratic people party of Laos came to power in 1975.

Who controls the government of Laos?

The republic democratic people party of Laos came to power in 1975. The executive power is controlled by the president and elected by the national assembly for a 5 year period. The president is assisted by the prime minister who, in turn, is in charge of the ministry council.

Is Laos a monarchy?

Under the 1957 constitution, Laos existed as a constitutional monarchy. The Lao People's Revolutionary Party is the only legally recognized political party in Laos, whose powers in the government are not stated in the constitution. The ruling party exercises unlimited executive power over the country and makes most of the decisions unopposed.

Which countries support the government of Laos?

The government also receives support from the Vietnam's People's Army and the Lao People's Army. The executive of Laos consists of the president, the prime minister, four deputy prime ministers and the council of ministers, making 28 members.

Who is the ruling party in Laos?

One brief reference to the ruling party is made in Article 3, which states that the "rights of the multiethnic people to be the masters of the country are exercised and ensured through the functioning of the political system with the Lao People's Revolutionary Party as its leading nucleus."

What laws must comply with the Constitution of Laos?

All laws must comply with the Constitution. Only the National Assembly has the right to amend the Constitution of the Lao People's Democratic Republic. The Constitution can be adopted when it has the affirmative votes of more than two-thirds of the total number of the National Assembly members.
