What is a photovoltaic power station?

A photovoltaic power station, also known as a solar park, solar farm, or solar power plant, is a large-scale grid-connected photovoltaic power system (PV system) designed for the supply of merchant power.

Where are photovoltaic power stations located in China?

The installed capacities of China's photovoltaic power stations equal and above 50 MW are unevenly distributed, as presented in Fig. 1. As for geographical distribution, the photovoltaic power stations over 50 MW are mainly located in Qinghai, Ningxia, Guizhou, Gansu, Shaanxi, Inner Mongolia, and Hebei.

Where are photovoltaic power stations used?

In general, photovoltaic power stations have been built in most countries and regions in the world [12,13]. In Brazil, the off-grid photovoltaic energy systems were widely used for electrification in remote areas [14,15]. As for the planning stage, the accuracy of photovoltaic power generation forecast was also conducted [16,17].
