

Why did Moldova impose a state of emergency?

(AP Photo/Aurel Obreja) CHISINAU, Moldova -- Moldova's parliament on Friday voted in favor of imposing a state of emergency in the energy sector over fears that Russia could leave the European Union candidate country without sufficient natural gas supplies this winter.

Does Moldova have a good energy sector?

Moldova is also on the right path to developing a sound institutional structure in the energy sector, informed by better statistical data. The National Bureau of Statistics (NBS) is commended for its efforts to improve energy data collection and reporting.

What is Moldova's long-term goal in the electricity sector?

In the electricity sector, Moldova's long-term objective was to fully interconnect with the European Network of Transmission System Operators for Electricity (ENTSO-E). This was achieved significantly earlier than planned, due to Russia's invasion of Ukraine in late February 2022.

What are the sources of electricity and gas imports in Moldova?

The sources of electricity and gas imports are not diversified and crucially depend on gas supply from Russia and electricity supply from the Moldavskaya GRES power station, which operates beyond the control of the Moldovan government.

What is Moldova's energy self-sufficiency?

Moldova's energy self-sufficiency is among the lowest in the world: only around 25% of its energy demand is covered by domestic production, consisting almost entirely of solid biomass and variable renewable energy sources.

The objective goal set in the Moldovan Energy Strategy 2030 to increase the share of renewables in the final energy consumption to 17% in 2020 was overreached (25% in 2020), mainly because of heating (share of 41%), as the share for electricity was only 3% and that for transport 0.2%.

In 2022, Moldova experienced one of its worst energy crises because of the Russian invasion of Ukraine. Through international cooperation, Moldova seeks to implement its energy strategy by 2030 for energy independence, security, structural modernization, and diversification.

Moldova was an observer to the treaty establishing the Energy Community from the outset (2006). Following its interest in full membership, the European Commission was mandated to carry out accession negotiations with Moldova in 2007.
