

# Nigeria advance solar energy

What is the future of solar energy in Nigeria?

As the most populous country in Africa, Nigeria faces significant energy challenges, including limited access to electricity and over-reliance on fossil fuels. Does Nigeria have solar power?

Nigeria has immense solar energy potential, with an average solar radiation of 4.8-5.4 kWh/m<sup>2</sup>; per day. According to estimates, the country has the capacity to generate over 1,000 GW of solar power. Exploiting this potential can significantly contribute to meeting Nigeria's growing energy demand and reducing its dependence on fossil fuels.

Why do Nigerians need more solar energy?

Most Nigerians are aware of more health and environmentally friendly options such as solar energy, but cost, quality and lack of expertise make implementing them difficult. That is why more investment in solar energy is needed, said Segun Adaju, the president of the Renewable Energy Association of Nigeria.

Is solar energy a viable energy source in Nigeria?

The Nigerian government recognizes the immense potential of solar energy and has taken proactive steps to promote its adoption. The Federal Ministry of Power, Works, and Housing has formulated policies and frameworks to facilitate the integration of solar power into the national energy mix.

Do solar PV systems work in Nigeria?

As for now, solar PV systems are applied to specific areas in Nigeria "merely to provide additional power or to provide backup power in moments of fluctuating power supply or power outage" [43]; these areas include telecom masts, street lights, and parks, etc.

How many megawatts of electricity can a solar system generate in Nigeria?

A 2019 report (PDF) by the director-general of the Energy Commission of Nigeria estimated that if one percent of Nigeria's land area were to be covered with a solar technology of five percent efficiency, about 333,480 megawatts of electricity could be generated, which is "more than enough for the country".
