

Does North Macedonia have solar energy?

However, in the recently submitted final draft of its National Energy and Climate Plan to the Energy Community, North Macedonia has a provision of 400MW solar energy generated from household rooftops PVs.

What is the energy strategy for North Macedonia?

The Ministry of Economy of North Macedonia announced earlier in 2020 that "the (energy) strategy envisions investments in photovoltaic power plants which are expected to have a total installed capacity of 1.357 MW, or 41.8% of the total installed capacity for energy production."<sup>41</sup> 36 European Commission.

How much energy does North Macedonia need to make 1 EUR?

In fact, North Macedonia needs to spend 0.24 toe (2.8 MWh) of energy to make 1 EUR, unlike EU28 where only 0.1 toe (1.2 MWh) is needed. Proposed measures, especially in the area of energy efficiency, will increase the productivity without increasing energy consumption, bringing North Macedonia closer to the EU 28 average. Figure 11.
