Who owns South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands?

Where is South Georgia located?

The South Georgia Group lies about 1,390 kilometres (860 mi; 750 nmi) east-southeast of the Falkland Islands, at 54°S; 36°W. It comprises South Georgia Island itself, by far the largest island in the territory, and the islands that immediately surround it and some remote and isolated islets to the west and east-southeast.

Why is South Georgia a marine protected area?

On 23 February 2012, to protect marine biodiversity, the territory's government created the South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands Marine Protected Area - comprising 1.07 million km² (410,000 sq mi). After the Falklands War in 1982, a full-time British military presence was maintained at King Edward Point on South Georgia.

Are South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands mountainous?

South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands are a collection of islands in the South Atlantic Ocean. Most of the islands, rising steeply from the sea, are rugged and mountainous. At higher elevations, the islands are permanently covered with ice and snow.

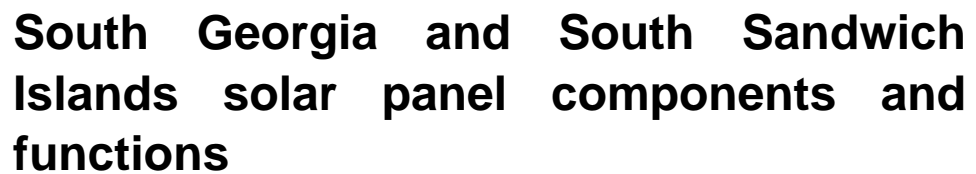

South Georgia & the South Sandwich Islands is at the northern limit of the krill distribution. 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The climate is classified as polar, and the weather is highly variable and harsh. Typical daily maximum temperatures in South Georgia at sea level are around 0 °C in winter (August) and 8 °C in summer (January). Winter minimum temperatures are typically about -5 °C and rarely dip below -10 °C. Annual precipitation in South Georgia is about 1,500 mm, much of ...

The island of South Georgia is unusual among oceanic islands for having pre-Cretaceous sedimentary rocks underlying much of the island and a significant portion of felsic igneous rocks. Two-thirds of the island consists of intensely folded flysch, capped with Aptian age fossils, tuff and greywacke in the Cumberland Bay Series.

A sequence of multi-faceted events and initiatives began to unfold in the hopes of adding protections to the area. The archipelagos became protected under the South Georgia and South Sandwich Islands Marine Protected Area (SGSSI-MPA) in 2012, becoming one of the world's largest MPA's, spanning an area of 1.24 million square kilometers.
