

Is the energy sector under a massive attack in Ukraine?

"The enemy continues its terror. Once again, the energy sector across Ukraine is under massive attack," Ukrainian energy minister German Halushchenko said on his official Facebook page. The extent of the damage had yet to be clarified, he said, while urging people to remain in shelters.

How has Russia impacted Ukraine's energy system?

For the second consecutive winter, Russia has increased military attacks on Ukraine's energy system, significantly undermining the security of the country's power supply.

How important is Ukraine's energy sector?

Ukraine's air defences provided some protection, but the scale of the attack and the resulting disruption highlighted once again the vital strategic importance of Ukraine's energy sector, as well as the ever-present risks to the country's energy supply.

Can Ukraine recover power from a decentralized energy system?

Whatever the future, the decentralized nature of some clean energies, in particular wind and solar, has allowed Ukraine to quickly restore power in ways that would be impossible with Ukraine's more traditional energy sources, such as coal-fired power plants.

What happened to Ukraine's thermal energy plants?

Ukraine's largest private energy company, DTEK, said its thermal energy plants had suffered "significant damage", resulting in blackouts. The country's state-owned energy operator, Ukrenergo, says it will enforce "restriction measures" for the whole of Ukraine on Monday.

How important is interconnection to Ukraine's electricity security?

Interconnection with the main European system has made a crucial contribution to Ukraine's electricity security, with the limit on cross-border trade increasing to 1.7 GW in November 2023. Before the 2022 invasion, Ukraine's power system was interconnected with the Russian and Belarussian grids.
