How many Watts Does a 200 watt solar panel produce?

Solar panels are rated in perfect conditions, meaning that under optimal solar irradiance (1000 W/m²) and perfect temperature (77°F), a 200 Watt solar panel will produce 200 watts. However, in the real world, and depending mainly on how sunny it is, that same panel will realistically produce anywhere from 0 to 180 Watts. Related topics:

What is a 200 watt solar panel kit?

200-watt solar panel kits are often simply two 100-watt panels sold together to produce 200 watts of power. 200 watts is slightly below what is considered "standard" in the residential solar panel market, and a 200-watt solar panel kit will produce less electricity than most residential panel models.

What does wattage mean on a solar panel?

You'll often see it referred to as "Rated Power", "Maximum Power", or "P_{max}", and it's measured in watts or kilowatts peak (kWp). For example, the nameplate from my solar panel specifies a Wattage output of 100W, meaning that the solar panel is capable of producing 100 Watts of power under ideal conditions.
