

How to wire solar panels together?

Wiring solar panels together can be done with pre-installed wires at the modules, but extending the wiring to the inverter or service panel requires selecting the right wire. For rooftop PV installations, you can use the PV wire, known in Europe as TUV PV Wire or EN 50618 solar cable standard.

How to add Solar connectors to PV wires?

Insert the lower components of the connector (terminal cover, strain reliever, and compression sleeve). Insert the upper components (safety foil, male/female MC4 connector housing, O-ring).
