Where are solar panels located?

Usually, solar panels of a self-consumption system are located on the roof, although it is not the area closest to the storage system or energy meters. For security and architectural integration reasons, the roof of the buildings is usually determined as the location area for the solar panels.

How are solar panels positioned?

Each row or 'table' will be separated by approximately 2.5 - 3.0 metres to avoid the adjacent row casting shadows and blocking the sunlight to other panels. The solar panel 'tables' are positioned at an angle of between 25 - 30 degrees from the ground facing in a southwards direction to capture the most sunlight possible.

With ground mounts, solar panels are mounted on freestanding frames placed in open areas of your property like your yard or garden. However, free-standing solar panels can also be valuable as they can be placed facing south and at any angle you wish.

What angle should a solar panel be positioned?

The solar panel 'tables' are positioned at an angle of between 25 - 30 degrees from the ground facing in a southwards direction to capture the most sunlight possible. This angle means the back of the panel sits higher, at approximately 2.5m above current ground level, than the front edge at 0.8m above ground level.
